



November 2010 Election: New Members of the California Legislature

Nearly a third of the California Legislature turned over with the November 2 election, bringing many new legislators to the Capitol. In all, 38 of the legislature's 120 seats (10 in the Senate and 28 in the Assembly) will have new occupants, most due to term limits. Since the passage of term limits in 1990, legislators are limited to three two-year terms in the Assembly and two four-year terms in the Senate. Newly elected Senators will serve until 2014, while newly elected Assembly Members will be up for election again in 2012. The new session of the California Legislature will convene on December 6.

Below are listed all of the Senate and Assembly districts in which there was a change in legislator. Districts which are not listed either did not have an election or the incumbent won the election. Also listed are the counties each legislator represents to make it easy to figure out whether or not you have a new legislator representing your county. In addition, the tables include details about the new legislators' previous occupations. To see if a new legislator has accepted any money from tobacco interests, you can search by their name on the Center's *Database of Campaign Contributions of Tobacco Interests*, available at www.Center4TobaccoPolicy.org/database. Contributions data is through June 2010 – members that served in the 2009-2010 legislative session are listed on the Current Legislator search; candidates or members that served in the legislature prior to the 2009-2010 session are listed on the past legislators search; if a new legislator's name is not listed on either search it means they have not taken any tobacco interests' contributions through June 2010.
