## **Petition for Smokefree Choice in Multi-Unit Housing in Pasadena**

Secondhand smoke is a health hazard, containing over 60 known cancer-causing chemicals. Tobacco smoke can drift from unit to unit and to other parts of residential buildings (e.g. through air vents, hallways, windows, cracks, electrical outlets). Outdoor tobacco smoke can also drift into a unit. Frequent and recurring exposure to tobacco smoke can cause asthma, heart disease, cancer, and Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS), as well as worsen chronic illnesses. Children, the elderly and the disabled are especially vulnerable to secondhand smoke exposure.

**By signing this petition, I am asking the Pasadena City Council to adopt policies that safeguard residents from unwanted drifting tobacco smoke in multi-unit housing.** Non-smoking sections should be made available in residential buildings just as they are in hotels. Residents should be informed where smoking/non-smoking units are located.
