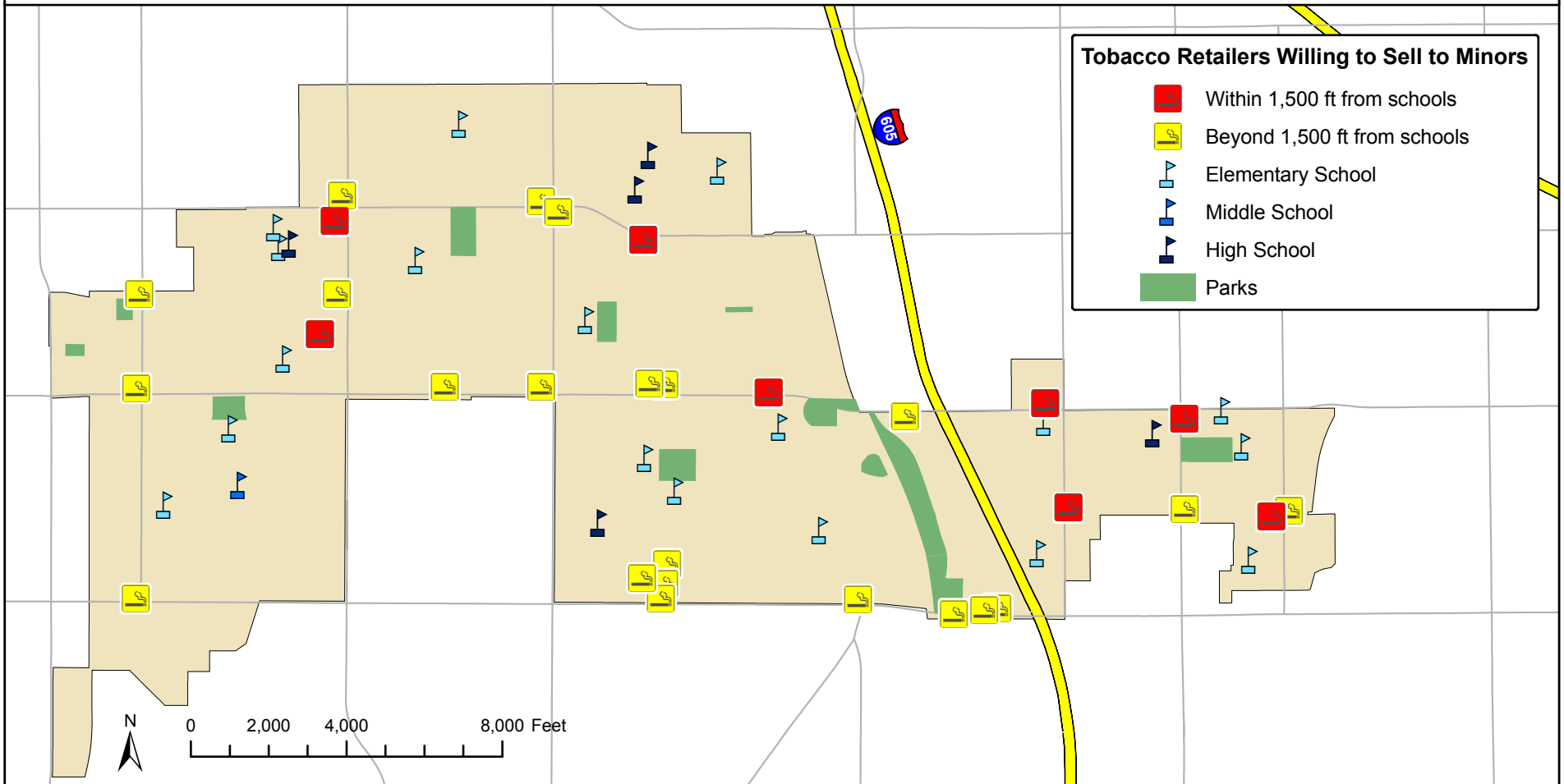


Tobacco Retailers Willing to Sell to Minors

Lakewood

Office of Samoan Affairs conducted Youth Purchase Surveys in January 2010 to identify tobacco retailers that were willing to sell tobacco to minors. Of the 67 retailers that were surveyed, 44.8% were willing to sell tobacco to a minor. Of the 30 tobacco retailers that were willing to sell, 8 were located within walking distance (1,500 ft) from schools.
